Exceptions: F36/7, F46/7, F56/7, X36/7, X46/7, X56/7, W36/7, W46/7, W56/7 are available in more than one cab-to-axle and wheelbase. When using these model numbers, we must know either the cab-to-axle or the wheelbase to know exactly what unit is being described (see below).

F36/7 is available in 141" WB (60" CA) and 165" WB (84" CA)

F46/7 and F56/7 are available in 141" WB (60" CA), 165" WB (84" CA), 189" WB (108" CA) and 201" WB (120" CA)

W36/7, W46/7 and W56/7 are available in 176" WB (60" CA) and 200" WB (84" CA)
